## **SUMMARY OF ELECTRICITY GENERATION VOLUME OF POWER PLANTS FOR THE FIRST QUARTER OF 2025**

This announcement is made by Beijing Energy International Holding Co., Ltd. (the “**Company**”, collectively with its subsidiaries, the “**Group**”) to keep the shareholders and potential investors of the Company informed of the latest business development of the Group. The board of directors of the Company announces that according to the Group’s preliminary operation statistics, the 247 power plants beneficially owned by the Group and its associates have generated electricity in an aggregate volume of approximately 6,087,012 megawatt-hours (“**MWh**”) in the first quarter (“**Q1**”) of 2025.

- (1) The total capacity on-grid mode refers to the settlement of all electricity volume generated by a power plant with the grid; while the surplus capacity on-grid mode means that a portion of the electricity volume generated by a power plant is sold directly to the end-user and the surplus electricity is settled with the grid.
- (2) Some of the power plants of the Group increased grid-connection with further installed capacity of approximately 173MW in total in Q1 of 2025.
- (3) There were six solar power plants self-constructed by the Group, which achieved grid-connection with total installed capacity of approximately 386MW in Q1 of 2025.
- (4) The operation figures previously announced have been adjusted to be in line with the available accounting figures and to reflect the changes in the Group's portfolio of power plants with effect from each transaction's respective completion date.
- (5) The figures provided herein are subject to rounding adjustment and will also be subject to other possible adjustments due to accounting procedures.
